Code of conduct - School uniform and appearance

All learners are expected to wear the official school uniform with pride, both on and off the school premises. When in school uniform, a student's conduct, speech and appearance must always enhance the image of Verney College.

- Blue Verney College golf shirt; grey school trousers; blue Verney pullover; Verney blazer is compulsory for all learners from Grade 7 Grade 12.
- Smooth, black lace-up leather shoes (no tackies); girls wear white socks; boys wear navy or grey socks. Girls may wear only navy-blue stockings.
- Boys must keep their hair short, neat and tidy at all times.
- Boys may not wear jewellery in the form of rings, arm bands, necklaces or earrings.
- Boys must be clean-shaven at all times. No exceptions for religious or cultural beliefs.
- Girls' hair must be tied up, and away from the face. Only white, black or navy hair accessories may be used to tie up hair.
- Highlights in hair are not allowed, neither are unnatural hair colours.
- Girls must keep their nails short. Nail polish and/or false tips are not allowed.
- Girls are not allowed to wear any make-up.
- Girls may wear one earring per ear in the lowest piercing. Only gold studs or silver studs and sleepers may be worn.
- Hoodies are not allowed.
- T-shirts or vests worn under the Verney golf shirt should not be visible.
- PE only the school shorts, track suit and white takkies to be worn.
- If for whatever reason there is a problem regarding the correct uniform being worn, a letter must be written by a parent/guardian indicating the problem and a date by which the issue will be rectified.
- Civvies no nose, eyebrow or tongue rings to be worn.
- During exam periods students are to wear the correct school uniform.

VERNEY COLLEGE CODE OF CONDUCT

STUDENTS SCHOOL RULES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

- All learners are expected to wear the official school uniform with pride, both on and off the school premises. When in school uniform, a student's conduct, speech and appearance must always enhance the image of Verney College.
- No learners are to be admitted to class after the bell rings without an explanation from the office.
- Learners may not leave the school premises during school hours without permission from the Principal or Deputy Principal.
- Full school uniform must be worn at all times.
- Possession, use, transmission, or visible evidence of the use of narcotics or unauthorised drugs is an offence and prohibited.
- Smoking at any time, or the possession of e-cigarettes, tobacco, devices used for consuming tobacco or nicotine (such as, but not confined to, electronic cigarettes and vaping, whether containing nicotine or not) is prohibited and considered a serious offence that could lead to immediate expulsion.
- Fighting, victimization and intimidation will not be tolerated. Regard this as a final warning.
- Students are expected to treat the property with respect. Any form of vandalism will not be tolerated. The damaging or defacing of school and/or any person's property will be regarded as a serious offence. Offending students will pay the costs of damaged property.
- Students are expected to assist staff in keeping the school premises neat and clean. Littering is not permitted.
- Behaviour on the corridors and school premises must be orderly.
- Verney College is committed to academic excellence and will not tolerate disruption of lessons by any learner.
- All homework assignments to be completed timeously.
- Cell phones are not allowed during school hours. Phones need to be handed in to the office by 8am till 14h10. If students are found to be in possession of their phone, then the phone will be confiscated for one term. Specific permission must be given by a teacher, if it is to be used in a lesson.
- Absence on a school day or an examination must be excused with a valid certificate/letter.
- The school does not take any responsibility for electronic devices brought to school.
